- *Foundation* (color matching skin). For even application, make sure to blend into neckline. This should only even face not drastically change the color.
- *False Eyelashes for all students 12 and older*, make sure to buy glue to adhere to eyes because the adhesive that comes on the lashes is not sufficient. Start at the inside of the eye and work outward, staying extremely close to lash line. Once on curl the false lash with your own then add mascara.
- *Black Mascara* for both false and real eye lashes and then curl with eye lash curler. This will fuse them together and curl the lashes out of dancer's eyes.
- *Eye shadow* (browns or purples and white). Apply white over the entire lid, followed by the darkest color in the crease.
- *Black eyeliner* on the lash line over both false and real lashes.
- *Lipstick* (Wet N' Wild #539A Cherry Frost) .99 at most drug stores & Amazon
- *Blush*. Apply dark color to contour the hollows of cheeks, a brighter color in an upward stroke from the apple of cheeks toward corner of eye, and the lightest color should be blended on top of apples of cheeks. Finally, blend the entire face in upward strokes).

Under the age of 7 at minimum apply lip stick & cheeks

Performance Bun

- All bangs should be pulled back with NO wisps of hair around the face. The bun should be slightly below the crown of the head. *If you can see the bun from the front, then it is too high.* Most times it is easier to put your hair up when wet because this will hold in all the little wispy hairs prior to hair spraying.
- Pull hair into a high ponytail; twist or braid hair and tie off with elastic; wrap hair around ponytail holder until all hair is in the bun (bobby pinning as you wind the hair is helpful).
- Bobby pin the bun so that the hair will not move!
- Wrap a fine nylon hair net (color should match hair and can be found for \$2.00/3 nets at any drug store) around the bun over and over until there is nothing left to twist.

Load on the hair spray or gel so it doesn't move and there are no wisps
