

Theatrical stage make – up

- NEW • Foundation (*Monday 6pm & Tuesday 4pm class only*)
- 101 False eye lashes & Performance earrings (I have some pierced to purchase \$4.00 each) (*Monday 4pm, 6pm & Tuesday 4pm class*)
- Mascara (all students)
- Lip stick Wet N' Wild #539A Cherry Frost (all students) .99 cents at most drug stores
- Blush (apply in an upward stroke from apple of cheeks toward corner of eye)
- Eye shadow (browns or purples and white) Apply white on the lid, add a darker color in the crease of the eye lid Saturday 11am not necessary

If hair style calls for Classical Bun

*All bangs should be pulled into the bun
Bun should be slightly below the crown of your head.

Hint #1

Do not place the bun directly on top of head! We should be able to see the hair accessory not the entire bun.

Hint #2

Most times it is easier to put your hair up when wet this will hold in all the little wispy hairs

- Pull hair into a high ponytail
- Twist or braid hair tie off with elastic
- Wrap hair braid around ponytail holder until all hair is in the bun
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Hint # 3 sometimes bobby pining as you wind up the hair is helpful for those with a lot of hair

- Bobby pin hair using pins the color of your hair (or as close as you can get) Pin until bun will not move!
- Wrap a fine nylon hair net (same color as hair) around the bun over and over until there is nothing left to twist and wrap.
- Load on the hair spray
