Friday, June 14th – MANDATORY DRESS REHEARSAL at Concord Auditorium (2 Prince street Concord bring all costumes after this show they are the dancers property) This is a closed rehearsal so unless you are a room supervisor or part of the backstage crew you must wait in the lobby or come back at the end of your child's rehearsal time. *Bring all costumes, tights, shoes hair in a bun

Start time – 5:00 ends at 7:30pm please be in the lobby by 7:15pm.

Saturday, June 15th - TPCD Recital Day at Concord Auditorium (2 Prince Street Concord)

1:30pm: All students should be in their dressing rooms and in their first costumes 2:00pm: The show begins.

- For safety reasons, please use the outside stage door to get to your assigned dressing room. *Do not go through the audience.*
- Students are not allowed to go out into the audience or lobby with their costumes on before the show or during intermission.

FYI

- There is to be NO saving of seats to do so may result in removal from the theater at the <u>House</u> <u>Manager's</u> discretion.
- Recording the show is no longer allowed, removal from the theater will be at <u>the House</u> <u>Manager's discretion</u>.
- No flash photography, phone calls or playing games on devices while the performance is in progress. The lit-up screen is a big distraction to the people around you and to the dancers.
- Theater etiquette asks that our audience be quiet and respectful while the students are performing and to give your full attention to all the students. If you must leave your seat, please do so before or after a dance, not during so as not to distract the dancers and to be courteous to those around you.
- Before leaving, all students must pick up their dressing rooms, do not leave bobby pins on the floor. The City of Concord has made this mandatory to rent the theater space. Room supervisors please make sure your kids do this.
- There is to be no eating/drinking in the theater or dressing rooms at any time, however water bottles are acceptable - to do so will result in the student not being able to take part in the recital. This rule includes family members, as well. No gum chewing on the premises. These rules will be strictly enforced
