

Covid Policy for our 2021 – 2022 season

*To keep our students and teachers safe and to continue the dance year safely
the following rules will be implemented*

All TPCD teachers, student apprentice and room helpers are vaccinated, if they need to come in close contact with a student a mask will be worn.

Entrance Policy

- Wait on the porch deck until each class is let in by a teacher
- Masks will be worn while entering the building going through the check in process and getting ready for class
- Masks will be optional once in the dance room (parental decision)
- Temperature checks at the door (only if numbers go up in our area, we will monitor this continually)
- Sanitize hands upon entering
- These rules are subject to change as we feel necessary

Our safety measures

- Students dance in 6 X 6 socially distanced boxes
- The waiting room will remain closed
- All props and common ballet bars are cleaned in between classes
- Air purifier is on throughout the dance day



If a student or anyone in a student's family has the below symptoms or the student has encountered someone with these symptoms the student MAY NOT come to dance. Sending a student anyway will result in immediate removal from Turning Pointe. We take the health of all students, teachers, and our community seriously and want to do all we can to keep running our studio throughout the year while giving the students a safe environment, but we need transparency from everyone.

If a student has any symptoms of COVID-19 DO NOT SEND THEM TO DANCE

Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting or Diarrhea
