



Financial Responsibility & Deadlines

Tuition Information

- Tuition is due the first class of each month. If you have provided a credit card, the system is set up for automatic payment. When you register, your card will be charged on the 1st of each month for any outstanding charges for the month including lessons, late fees, costumes, performance packages etc. If you do not wish for this feature to be used there is a box to uncheck in the credit card area of the registration form which then will become your responsibility to pay all charges on time. There is NO separate service fee for tuition payments.
- If paying by check it should be made out to TPCD if paying with cash, please put in an envelope with the student's name on it and place in the lock box on the danceroom door or mail in your payment again it must be to the studio by the 15th.
- Returned checks will be assessed with a \$30.00 fee.
- There are no refunds for any reason.

FYI These rules will be strictly enforced:

- There is a dress code for each class. Once registered, you will receive a list of needed items. Do not purchase anything until you receive the dress code and then mandatory purchase shoes and tights through www.shopnimbly.com/TPCD. This way all students' shoes and tights match. The Nimbly site will have a pop up that tells you when ordering shoes for **children's sizes order 2 sizes larger**.
- TPCD follows the Pembroke school system's vacations, snow days not teacher workshop or half days. Closures due to the weather will be announced on our website, social media & studio answering machine and through text for those signed up to receive them. If ever in doubt, call the studio, (603) 485-8710 or send us an email.
- Email is the studio's primary methods of communication along with our website, studio bulletin board and post to our Face Book page. It is your responsibility to keep up to date on studio information so check your email and the studio web site regularly. There will be Text reminders of upcoming payment deadlines for those that signed up for them in the registration process.

Annual Performances

- December 14, 2024: Nutcracker, 2:00pm. Hip Hop, Lyrical & Tap students do not participate this is strictly a ballet performance
December 13, 2024: Nutcracker dress rehearsal. All ballet students participate
December 12, 2024: On stage rehearsal
- June 14, 2025: Annual Recital, 2:00pm. ALL students participate
June 13, 2025: Recital dress rehearsal. All students participate
June 12, 2025: On stage rehearsal. All students participate

Performance Package Bundle:

- October 2024: Nutcracker Performance Package of \$200.00 per family includes 5 Nutcracker tickets, costume rental fee, 2 pair of tights a Performance online link, and all online rehearsal fees. OPTIONAL a Nutcracker T-shirt that is \$25.00 extra.
- For the 2nd dancer in the family, there is an additional \$25 costume rental fee, there will not be a charge for the 2nd dancer's onstage rehearsals. If costumes are returned with damage, misuse, or in need of cleaning assessed at more than the rental fee, additional charges will be applied to the account. Extra tickets will be available to purchase for \$23.00 at the studio and \$25.00 at the door.
- April 2025: Recital Performance Package of \$200.00 per family is due. Package includes 5 Recital tickets, 1 show t-shirt, 2 pair of tights, Performance online link and all onstage rehearsal fees. OPTIONAL additional T-shirt for other dancers in the family the cost is \$25.00 each.

There is a \$5.00 service fee for paying online for Performance Packages & Costumes

Purchasing Recital Costumes

- November 2024: June recital costume deposit (\$25.00 per costume/per dance subject) due.
- February 2025: June recital costume balance due. Upon payment of the balance, recital costumes become property of the student. *Example: If the student is in a combination ballet/jazz class, you purchase one costume per subject with a total deposit of \$50.00
